What is Orienteering

Orienteering is a competitive form of land navigation. It is for all ages and degrees of fitness and skill. It provides the suspense and excitement of a treasure hunt. The object of orienteering is to locate control points by using a map and compass to navigate through the area.

Directions to the Event Centre

From Jo'burg, travel north on the R512 (Malibongwe / Pelindaba Road) towards Broederstroom. At the T-Junction with the R102 at the Sasol Garage, turn left, effectively staying on the R512. Stay on the R512 for 14.9km to the venue. Pass Oberon / Pecanwood Estate on the right and continue straight along the R560 towards Magaliesburg (do not follow R512 toward Sun City!). Signs for the venue will be on the left shortly after passing The Coves Estate.

Terrain	Le Godimo is a horse eventing and trials area. There are numerous mowed tracks and many horse jumps. There is almost no rock detail, but there are many sporadic thickets of vegetation that will make navigation demanding.
