Directions: Travel east on the N4 towards Emalahleni (previously the Witbank highway). Pass the Solomon Mahlangu offramp (previously Hans Strydom) and take the next offramp (exit 18) towards Boschkop/Donkerhoek. There is a R12,00 toll gate here. Turn right and continue over the bridge, onto the dirt road (R964) for just over 1km. Rosemary Hill is on the right—you will see the big green sign!
