What is Orienteering?

A competitive or non-competitive recreational activity in which participants use a map and compass to navigate between checkpoints along an unfamiliar route.

Venue

- The Coves is a private estate on the shores of Hartbeespoort Dam.
- The area has residential housing with a mixture of bushveld, grassveld, wooded bushveld forest and undeveloped stands.
- There is a club house at the venue, which will be selling food and drinks.

Organization	The event is organized by the Rand Orienteering Club (<u>www.roc.org.za</u>).

Format	The Sprint Cup will consist of two legs, a Prologue , followed by a Final , with the results of the Prologue determining the chasing start order of the Final. Overall results will combine the times of the two courses for participants. In addition, a course for the less competitive (the Explorer) will be available with an option to move to Men/Women for the final at no additional charge.	
Kids	A yellow course will be on offer, which is ideal for kids interested in their first orienteering event. Entry for the Yellow course in on-the-day only and is R20. No need to pre-enter.	
Water	There are no water points on the course. Please bring your own water if needed.
