WHERE

From the N14 (North or South), take the R511 off-ramp and head North along the R511 in the direction of Hartbeespoort. 2.4km later, take the slipway left to stay on the R511. After 13.3km along the Hennops Valley road, turn left at the sign to the Hennops Hadedea Camp and Hiking Trail.

Note: The turn-off to the venue is in the middle of a stop-and-go due to road works. Expect a 10-20 minute delay from either direction.

GPS: 25°47'53"S 27°59'23"E

Note - Please park at the main parking at Hadedea Camp. Follow the signs to the event centre. Please first pay the Venue Fee at reception before proceeding to the Orienteering registration desk. The venue registration entitles you to entry to the picnic area.
