B'sorah Farm - 3 June Long-0

From Johannesburg, travel north on the R512 (Malibongwe/ Pelindaba Road) towards Breoderstroom. At the T-Junction with the R102 at the Sasol garage, turn left effectively staying on the R512. After 4.0km turn left onto the R3/400 (Hartbeeshoek satellite road). B'sorah Farm and O signs will be on the left after 9.3km.
