Competition area: The competition area for Day 1 events is situated in Klipkraal map North-East. It lies about 8km north of Sabie off the R532 Graskop/Pilgrimsrest road. The competition area for Day 2 events is situated in Klipkraal map South-East.

The Event Centre remains the same for both days.

The terrain at Klipkraal consists of pine forests varying from 5 to 15 years, with generally good visibility but differing runnability. Expect some rocky outcrops along the gradually sloping area. No steep hills.

Event Centre: Registration, Start, Finish and Prizegiving will be held at the event centre. Parking on the side of the dirt road.

DIRECTIONS TO EVENT CENTRE

Day 1 + 2: From Sabie proceed in a northerly direction towards Graskop/Pilgrimsrest (R532). Drive approximately 8,5km and turn off right towards Wilgerboom. Follow the well-maintained, wide dirt road for 2km to registration.



Climate: The weather in the area in June is moderately chilly comfortable, with average highs of 22°C and lows of 7°C. Average monthly rainfall for this Winter period is negligible with only a 3% chance for precipitation.

Hazards: There are no dangerous animals in the competition area, although competitors may encounter species of buck, jackals, baboons, monkeys and other small animals. various Snakes (including venomous ones) are found in the area but they will usually get out of the runners way. No incidents have been reported due to snakes in similar areas used for Orienteering in South Africa. Ticks are prevalent in the area – appropriate repellant is advised.

Accommodation:

Social: Saturday afternoon. Informal picnic in the grassy area at the event centre, with a great view of the mountains. Please note – no open flames i.e. no braais or skottels.

Competition clothing: There is no restriction on competition clothing. However, leg protection is advised

Refreshments: There will be water at the event centre. Please note there is no water on the courses.

Toilets: There are toilet facilities at the Event Centre Day 1 & 2.

Medical: There will only be First Aid available at the Event Centre. The nearest fully equipped hospital is situated in Nelspruit (approximately 60km from the Event Centre). There is also a small Medical Facility in Sabie town.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Map Scales: The events will be run on 1:10,000 scaled maps, with a contour interval of 5 metres on A4. Map updated 2022.

Control Descriptions: Will be printed on all maps. All Control Descriptions are in symbol format (only Yellow and Orange courses receive text description sheets)


Electronic Timing System: The EMIT timing system will be used. EMIT cards will be available for hire for the each event (ie. must be returned once complete on each day).
