Blue (Tech 5; Phys 4)	±7.5km
Green (Tech 4; Phys 3)	±6km
Light Green (Tech 3; Phys 2)	±4km
Orange (Tech 2; Phys 1)	±2.5km
Yellow (Tech 1; Phys 1)	±1.2km

Terrain: Mix of hilly open land, rough veld, partially forested with undergrowth areas and the famous quarry. Leg covering recommended.
